4. Treasurer's Report and Adoption of the 2009 Budget: - Stuart Moir

5. Database Report: Wolfe Schoenne

We now have approx. 846 parcels of property with the Ridge and Alpine Meadows 507 are BC owned.

The tax base is just over \$2 Million (including school tax, commercial and residential)

7. 2008 Accomplishments:

- Website we are trying to upgrade to a dynamic site from the static site. This is in progress.
- Star Gas the utility applied for a rate hike and then declined this.
- NORD Governance Issues continue to be a problem
  - Waste Reduction Programme a downloadable flyer is to be finished giving members the guidelines for recycling.
- RCMP Community Policing This year a 55+ driver training programme was tried. We would like to see a CPR programme and speed traps to encourage slower driving.
- Tom Christianson Representatives of the SSPOA met with Tom to discuss Silverhawk utilities (sewer)
- Notices were forwarded re: the Cabin Colony Review
- The committee continued to have a positive working relationship with the resort.
- Pine Beetle: working with the resort, the volunteers posted the pouches. There were no new infestations and the plan is to continue.
- Garage Sale this was a successful community event raising \$400 for SSPOA and funds for the Adaptive Snow Sports group.
- Drew and Ted met with the Ministry of Highways about the summer road repairs.
- The 30 Km/hr signs were moved along the road to just before the Creekside entrance.
- The committee posted signs for Bear Aware –ness.
- We are trying to keep all informed with: 'Ted's Tidbits', emails, "Who're you gonna call?"; and regular photos of what's going on.
