- Community Notice Board and Mailbox Shelter (Drew) Showed photos of the proposed building to house the mailboxes, newspaper boxes and community notice board. Drew has been communicating with European Timber Frames. There will be pony walls on three sides. Silver Star has offered to provide lighting for the shelter. There will be interlocking brick and drainage. The building will be inline with the road. The engineering drawings have been received needed for Canada Post. We hope to do this summer provided approvals and funding is in place.

We will need sheeting for the roof, roofing, flooring and the pony walls. The size is approximately 24 ft. by 10 ft. The construction is solid Douglas Fir Beams. European

timber Frames estimates their cost to be about \$5000. It will cost about another \$1500 to finish.

## 8. Question and Answer:

Gary Esau asked about our fire rating. We are rated "semi-protected". The last audit was 5-6 years ago. We need a new audit, as the old one makes no sense now. Mike Macnabb and NORD are looking into this and are trying to get us up to the 3A rating, which is "Fully Protected".

Simone Dickie asked about the shelter drainage affecting Creekside. The drainage of the shelter will not affect Creekside.

Eric Young commented that the red sign next to the Bear Aware sign leads to the evacuation plan and were provide thanks to Capri Insurance.
